

BYLAW NUMBER 209-10
SUMMER VILLAGE OF ROCHON SANDS

A Bylaw of the Summer Village of Rochon Sands, in the Province of Alberta, for the purpose of adopting the Buffalo Lake Intermunicipal Development Plan, pursuant to provisions of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000 and amendments thereto.

WHEREAS, The Councils of Lacombe County, Camrose County, County of Stettler No. 6, and the Summer Villages of Rochon Sands and White Sands have recognized the need to cooperate in the planning of future land use and development around Buffalo Lake.

AND WHEREAS, Section 631 of the Municipal Government Act provides for two or more municipalities to jointly prepare an intermunicipal development plan for an area of common interest or concern.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Summer Village of Rochon Sands, in the Province of Alberta, adopts the Buffalo Lake Intermunicipal Development Plan, being the document attached hereto.

AND THEREFORE, Bylaw No. 156 is hereby rescinded.
